#### The speaker



Dr Philip Surman is a Research Fellow in The Computer Technology Department, and is in the Imaging and Displays Research Group of De Montfort University Leicester, England.

He will be giving an overview on the background of 3D viewing with glasses being handed out to all attendees to allow the viewing and appreciation of 3 dimensional images. The latest development by Dr Surman's Group in 3 dimensional television called MUTED (Multi User Television Displays) will also be discussed. This allows several people to watch a 3 dimensional television image at the same time without the need to wear special viewing glasses.

#### Directions to The Camera Club

The most straightforward way to get there is to use the Underground system and Northern Line getting out at Kennington. Turn left down Kennington Park Road, crossing over to the other side, and proceed for c. 5 minutes until reaching a right turn into Cleaver Square. Keep to the left pathway of Cleaver Square, and at the end a cut through path takes you to Bowden Street, where number 16 is to your left. Travel by car to Kennington Road (A23) to turn off to Cleaver Street and then Bowden Street. There is no car access from Kennington Park Road to Cleaver Square. Free car parking is available outside the club at the time of this talk.
